### TRASH-----

**W**e have had a complaint that someone is putting trash in the dumpster on the Jackson property (previously Lankford). They pay for this service and have issued a stern "threat" to anyone caught using it or being on their property. **PLEASE DO NOT USE THE DUMPSTER!** The Board is looking at the possibility of having dumpsters placed at 2 of the gates. But current lake policy is **"if you pack it in, pack it out !"** Bag your trash and dispose of it when you get home.
